



15 Easy steps to setup a web host account and upload your website from Adobe Dreamweaver CS6

1. Go to www.zymic.com and login
2. Create an account/Register in case you do not have an account yet
3. Login to www.zymic.com
4. You will be redirected to <http://www.zymic.com/zcp/> after a successful login
5. Create New Web Host Account and choose the name of the website you wish to create (**Follow this step only if you have not yet created a Web Host account**). After creating a web host account, go back to <http://www.zymic.com/zcp/>
6. Click on the orange login button (Figure 1)
7. Enter your **control panel account password** when prompted. You will use this information (Figure 2) to setup your FTP account in Dreamweaver in the following steps.

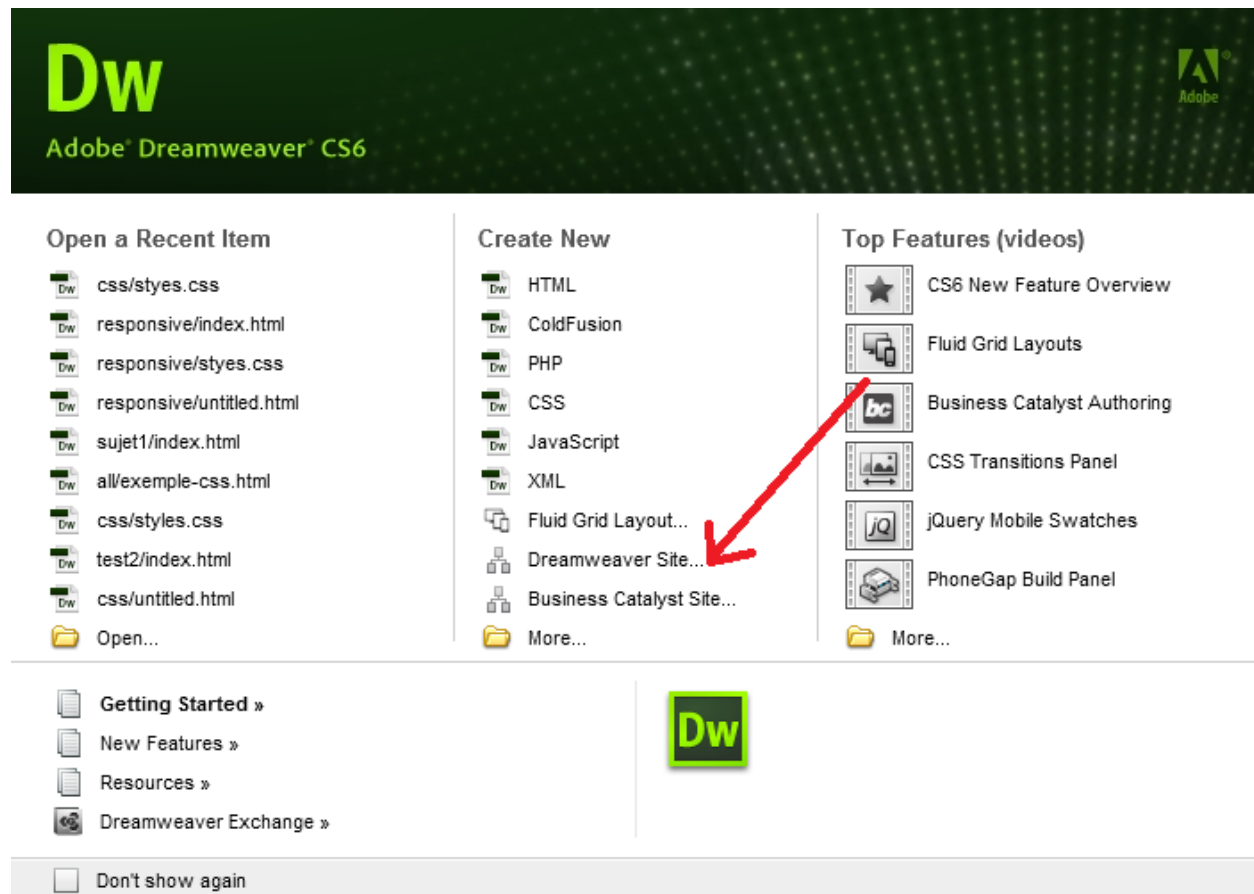


Figure 3 – Creating a Dreamweaver Site

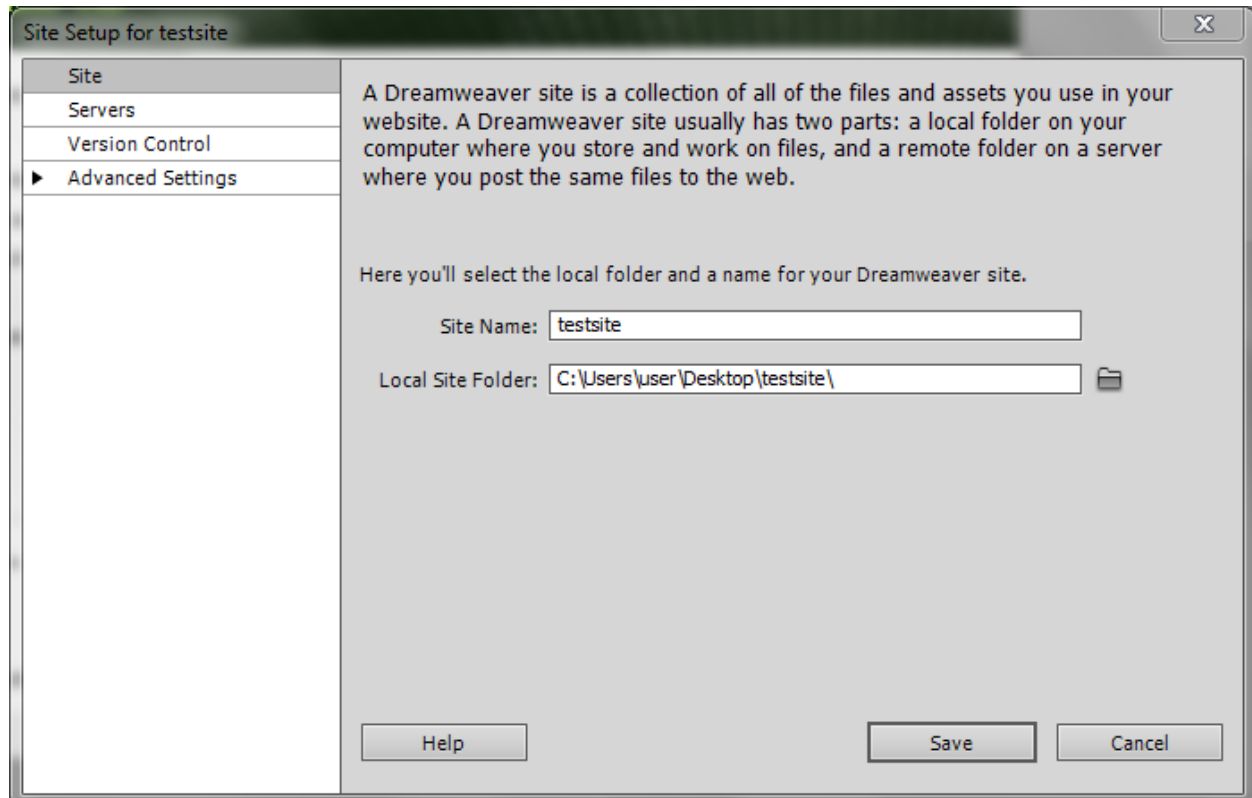


Figure 4 – Choose your site name and root folder where your website files will be stored locally

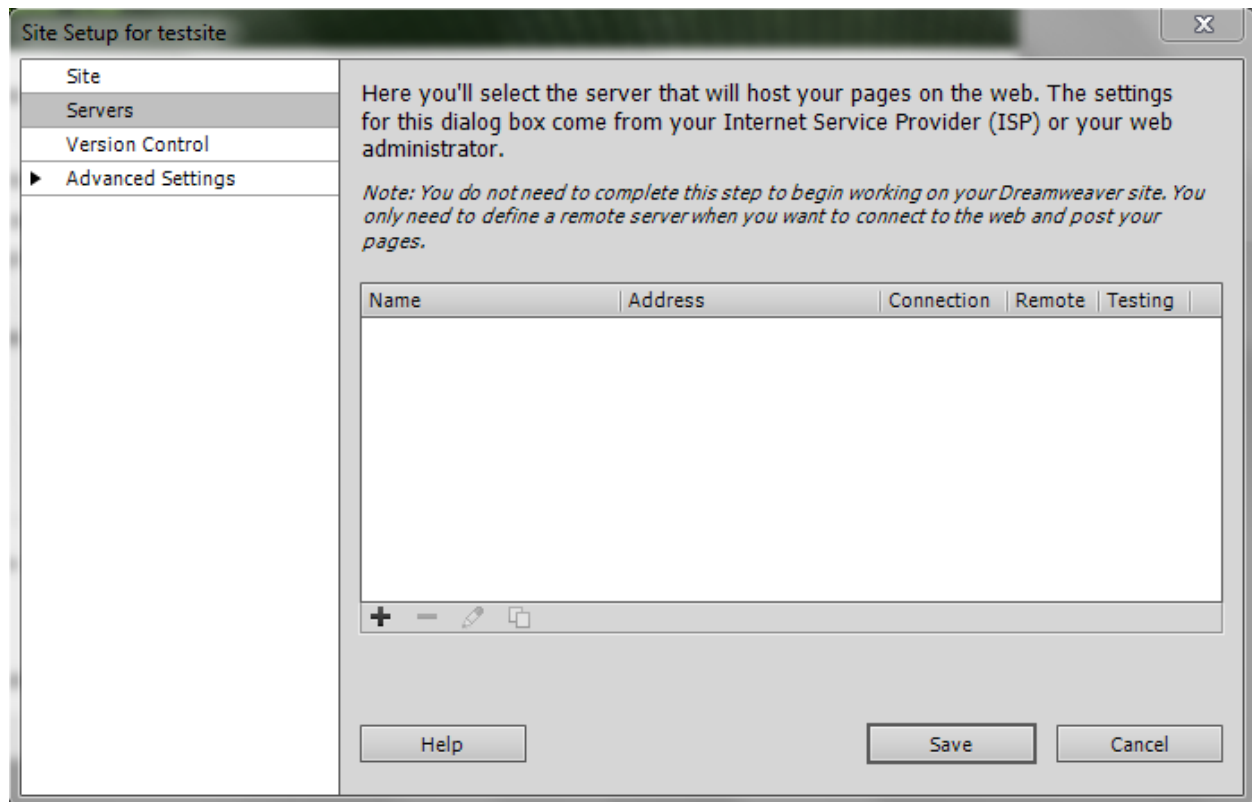


Figure 5 – Setting up the FTP server settings

8. Open Dreamweaver, click on Dreamweaver site (Figure 3), create a website (Figure 4), choose the server option from the left panel to configure your FTP account that will allow you to upload our website online (Figure 5).

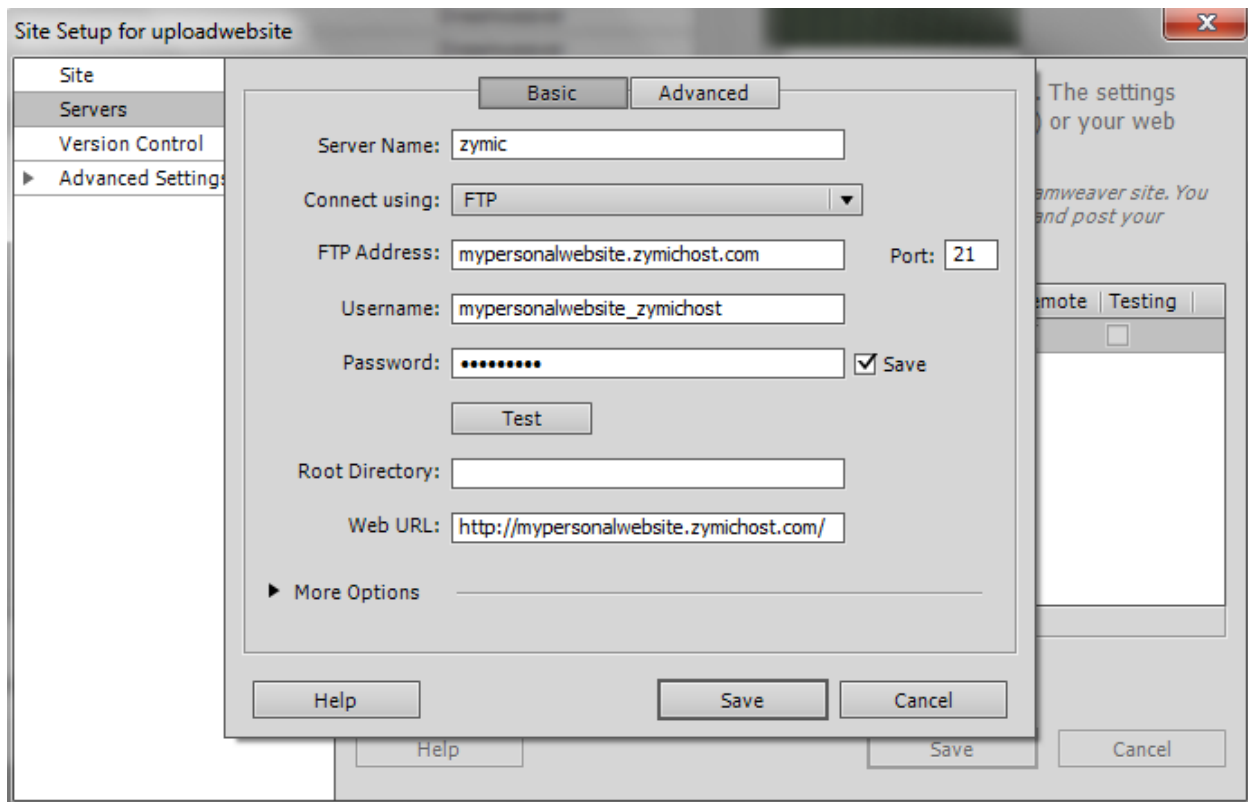


Figure 6 – Get the FTP information from zymic.com to Dreamweaver

9. Copy "Host" text from Figure 2 to FTP Address text field in Dreamweaver Figure 6.
10. Copy "Use" text from Figure 2 to Username text field in Dreamweaver Figure 6
11. Copy your website URL (find your website URL beside the orange login button in Figure 1) to the Web Url text field in Dreamweaver (Figure 6)
12. Put your password (**your control panel password**, NOT the password that you have initially logged in with)
13. Save your settings as you are ready to synchronize your website data between your local folder and your online website.

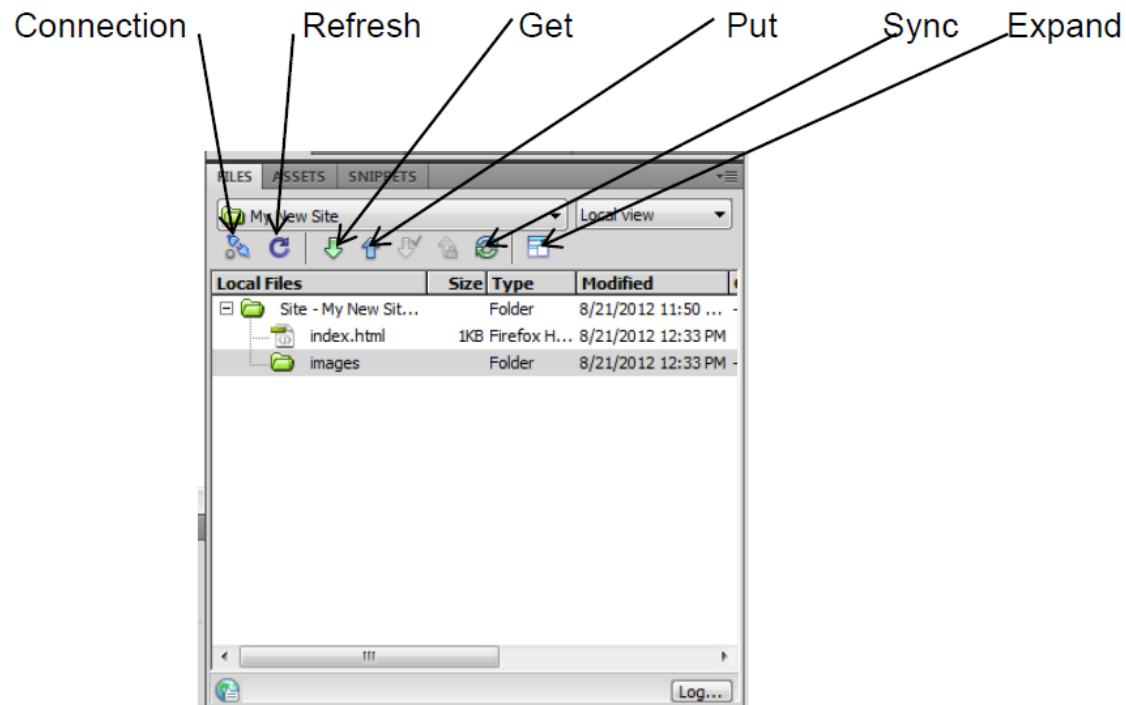


Figure 7 – Upload or download your website files

14. Use the put/get buttons (Figure 7) to upload and download your files.
15. Check that your files are correctly uploaded by going to your website URL (find your website URL beside the orange login button in Figure 1)
